In fact as I sat back and listened to the Dvorak Piano Quintet on the Sunday afternoon I reflected on so many of my own personal favourite moments. However as I left the hall for the last time that afternoon I felt only one thing... this is the beginning of something really special in Bangalow... something I want to watch grow into something huge... and the 2003 program has to be part of the natural growth of the Festival. So David Schneideman and I set to work almost immediately on what has turned out to be a knockout list of musicians and programs. I can say that I am thoroughly proud (and smiling like a Cheshire Cat actually) that our program boasts Ilya Konovalov (Concertmaster of the Israel Philharmonic Orchestra), Slava Grigoryan and his amazing brother Leonard in a duo guitar recital, the Tel-Aviv Piano Trio (fresh from the Melbourne International Chamber Music Competition), the Tank Stream Quartet (Winners of the 2002 Osaka International Chamber Music Competition), Marshall Maguire harp and stars from the 2002 Festival, the Southern Cross Soloists, Gregory Massingham and Michelle Walsh. I have two of my very favourite chamber works to bookend the Festival... The Mozart Clarinet Quintet and the Chausson Concerto Op.21 for Violin, Piano and String Quartet. And within those boundaries are pieces and collaborations that should rock the A & I Hall to its foundations. I simply can't wait to start. See you then.
